Terms and Conditions

'We'/'Us' RORC Rating Office

'The Club' The Club or Organisation with which the agreement is made

1. The Club must have an individual advocate who will administer the scheme at the club and work with owners on applications, assistance with getting boat data, etc.
2. We will offer a 15% reduction on the IRC standard and short-handed new application, revalidation and amendment fee.
3. The offer applies to any boat not having held an IRC certificate in the last 2 years or to boats who have previously applied via the IRC Start Up or Club Loyalty Scheme.
4. Each application must be on a completed Excel application form and accompanied with the batch sheet.
5. All applications must be submitted to us through the Club, with fees also paid by owners to the club.
6. The Club will be responsible for payment for all applications under this offer. We can confirm costs on request.
7. We will send revalidation information to the Club at the end of the year to be distributed to the owners who held certificates previously. This will include revalidation forms.
