

IRC COPY CERTIFICATES

Updated 19 June 2024

IRC rule 8.14: "On request and payment of a fee, and in accordance with any administrative rules published by the Rating Authority [RORC/YCF], the Rating Authority may supply a copy of a boat's valid or immediately expired IRC certificate, including owner name, to any interested party."

PLEASE NOTE: from 1st January 2024 IRC valid boat data is published on the IRC website, this may give you the information you are looking for without the need to purchase a full copy certificate: https://ircrating.org/boat-data-for-valid-irc-certificates/.

A fee is charged for IRC full copy certificates to reflect the information being supplied. Limitations are imposed to protect IRC from abuse and reverse-calculation, and this therefore helps protect existing boats from obsolescence.

Please note the following policy regarding the number and cost of copy certificates (per year):

First 10 copies £14 each (ex VAT)
Further 10 copies £50 each (ex VAT)
Further 10 copies £100 each (ex VAT)

No further copies will be permitted.

No more than 5 copies of any single design class will be allowed.

The RORC Rating Office reserves the right to alter this policy at any time at its entire discretion. Quoted fees are correct at the date on this document and may increase annually.

Certificates can be ordered by UK owners through MyIRC https://myirc.rorcrating.com (registration required); overseas owners should contact their IRC Rule Authority.
